- 5. Return your completed application Return your completed application to the "Board of Canvassers" in your city/town listed below.
- 6. Track your mail ballot Visit vote.ri.gov to sign up for *Ballottrax*. You will receive notifications on the status of your mail ballot application and mail ballot delivery information. Mail ballots are sent to voters approximately 3 4 weeks before the election. Election mail cannot be forwarded. Be sure to check the address where you want your mail ballot sent carefully.
- 7. Receiving your mail ballot Your mail ballot packet will have your ballot, instructions, voter's certificate and the required postage-paid envelope to return your voted ballot to the Board of Elections.
